2006 Camping Reservation Guidelines:

- You must be occupying site to make reservations for the following year.
- Sites in A campground, B campground and Overflow can be reserved. The Youth area is on a first come first serve basis. Sites in Youth area will not be available for camping prior to the 15th of April.
- Reservations will be taken on a first come first serve basis. (No more than one year in advance)
- No phone reservations will be accepted
- Limit 5 sites per reservation per person.
- Specific sites cannot be reserved
- Prices are as follows:

\$13.20 Semi-rustic (with electric and water) -88 sites

\$11.55 Rustic (no. electric or water)

\$2.00 per person per night for sites over 6 people

Campground Regulations:

- . All persons must comply with Federal, State and Local laws.
- . Park Rangers shall be responsible for the enforcement of Park Regulations
Anyone violating rules, destroying or defacing property or creating a disturbance may be evicted from the park.
- . Campsite capacity will include one motor home/camping unit and one tent using the electric and water provided. Campsite capacity is six people; any campers using additional units on a site will be charged \$2.00 per person per night. Also, additional units will not be permitted to use the electric on site due to our limited supply. All camping units must be located within a designated campsite area.
- . Campers must dispose of their garbage in the dumpsters located throughout the campgrounds. We will NOT provide curbside service
- . NO wood or ground fires in campgrounds or park. All fires in grills must be attended at all times.
- . There is a limit of two pets per campsite. All pets must be properly vaccinated and licensed and kept on a leash no longer than six feet at all times. Pets are not to be left unattended outside the camping unit. All pet owners are required to pick up after their pets.
- . Quiet hours are from 10:00 pm to 7:00 am. All guests of campers must leave area by 10:00 pm. Please be courteous of other campers. No bands are to perform in campgrounds at any time.
- . The use of blue boys for black water is strictly prohibited; they are to be used for gray water only. Also, the dumping of gray water is prohibited except in designated sewage disposal areas.
- . Lines are not permitted to be tied to trees in the park.
- . Firearms, Fireworks and hunting are prohibited.
- . Off road vehicles and ATVs are prohibited in the park.
- . Please secure all personal items. The park is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items.
